

How to Become a Licensed Family Child Care Home Tip Sheet Attend a Licensing Orientation (Family Child Care Home) • If you haven't completed a Family Child Care Home Orientation in the last 12 months, please register for it below. • Click here for more information. • Click <u>here</u> to register for the online orientation. • Click <u>here</u> to register for the live virtual orientation. • Please follow the instructions on the webpage. • You must contact (510) 622-2602 to register over the phone. • There is a \$25 nonrefundable orientation fee. Payment may be made by cashier's check, money order, or personal check payable to CDSS-CASHIER. LIC 9151 – Landlord Notification If you wish to care for only **6** children b. LIC 9149 – Landlord Consent Form If you wish to care for up to 8 children, you'll need your landlord's consent/signature. 7. LIC 9217 - Pre-licensing Readiness Guide ease note: If you are renting a home, you must submit LIC 9151 - Landlord



 Notification as proof of landlord notification so that you may care for up to 6 children. Landlord signature is not required. If you wish to care for up to 8 children, they must have their landlord sign LIC 9149 - Landlord Consent Form. If you own your home, they will want to see a copy of your deed.

O If you selected, "Child Care Providers," you shouldn't have to pay a fee to retrieve your certificate.
